3- Rules and Regulations

The Asian Shotgun Grand Prix will be conducted according to the ISSF and ASC Rules and Regulations Equipment control will be conducted according to the ISSF and ASC Rules and Regulations using instruments and devices approved by the ISSF.

ISSF Juries (Competition Jury, RTS / Equipment Control Jury) will be designated by the Asian Shooting Confederation to supervise the Asian Shooting Championship. Qualified Referees holding applicable ISSF licenses will conduct the competitions.

Shotgun Equipment

All skeet athletes must have ISSF seals with serial numbers on their marker tapes. Any shooting vests that do not have ISSF seals on the marker tapes must be submitted to Equipment Control for inspection and the affixing of a seal before the competition, if available.

Equipment Control will be conducted according to ISSF Rules using approved, calibrated instruments. Pre-competition testing is not mandatory; however, athletes are responsible for competing with legal equipment and clothing. All athletes are urged to submit any doubtful equipment and clothing to Equipment Control or the Shotgun Jury for checking before the competition. All athletes are subject to being selected for random testing during the competition. Athletes found to be in violation of the rules for guns or skeet marker tapes will be disqualified.

Cartridge Controls (Shotgun)

During Qualification, athletes whose cartridges are to be tested are selected by a computer draw. Between 10% and 18% of the athletes participating in an event will be selected for cartridge testing. Two (2) plus four (4) cartridges will be selected from each athlete and placed in separate labelled envelopes. The two (2) cartridges must be tested, first.

If both cartridges weigh 24.50 g and below, no further action will be taken. If one (1) or both cartridges weigh more than 24.50, then the four (4) cartridges in the second envelope

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must be tested. If the average of the six (6) cartridges weigh more than 24.50 g, then the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ), in accordance with Rule 9.4.3.1 (a).

During Final, all six (6) finalists must be tested using the same procedure. The Finalists or their Coaches/Officials must bring, as early as possible, but not later than 30 minutes before the scheduled start of the Final (Reporting Time), all the cartridges that will be used during the Finals and place them in separate Cartridge Control Boxes on the Finals field of play. The Finalists must report at least 15 minutes before the start of the Final. The Equipment Control Jury will take the necessary samples from the boxes; The boxes must be left under the supervision of a Shotgun Jury Member. Once ammunition is placed in the box, only the Equipment Control Jury or the Finalist can remove ammunition from the box. If additional cartridges are brought to a Finalist during Finals, samples from those cartridges must also be selected for testing. All cartridge controls must be completed before the start of the Presentation of the Finalists. Any disqualified (DSQ) athlete will not be allowed to participate in the Finals.

Colored Wads

Only transparent or translucent wads with no color may be used.

If an athlete uses ammunition that is not in accordance with Rule 9.4.3.1 a), then the athlete must be disqualified (DSQ).

Equipment Control

Equipment control will be open to competitors as scheduled in the Program of the competition

4- Participation:

Each ASC Member Federation can enter a maximum of five (5) athletes in individual events but only three (3) of them can be registered to compete for the medals. The other two (2) can only compete for Ranking Points, according to the ISSF General Regulation.

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5- Protests:

Any written protest (Protest Form P) must be submitted to a member of the Jury within ten (10) minutes after the end of the round in which the alleged incident occurred. The protest must be accompanied by a 50 EUR fee. If the protest is denied, the fee must be given to the Organizing Committee; if the protest is upheld the fee must be returned. (Rule 9.16.3.1)

Appeal Time Limit:

Such appeal must be submitted in written not later than ten (10) minutes after the Jury decision has been officially announced. The appeal must be accompanied by a 100 EUR fee. If the appeal is denied, the fee must be given to the Organizing Committee; if the appeal is upheld the fee must be returned, the protest fee is € 50 and appeal fee is € 100 - U.S Dollar equivalent is acceptable. using ISSF Protest Forms (available in the Organizing Committee office or the Chief Jury).

6- Entries

Entries are open for ASC Member Federations only and each participant must Register officially from his federation, all athletes participating must have an ISSF ID number. All shooters included in the Final Entry Form without an ISSF ID will not be entered in the competitions. ASC Member Federations must forward their Final Entries directly to the organizing committee, the final entry Deadline (30 days before the Official Arrival Day) which is 5th OCT 2025.

7- Entry Process:

Each ASC Federation entering the competition must submit the necessary forms (Annexes 1 - 9) and submit them before the following deadlines. All forms are available on the ASC / KSSF websites.

8- Registration

Registration, confirmation of entries at the Registration Office at the shooting complex, on arrival. 'Start' numbers will only be issued after confirmation.

9- Shooting Ranges:

The Competitions will take place in the Sheikh Sabah Al-Ahmad Olympic Range complex at Sulaibiya, Kuwait.

The Olympic Shotgun Ranges – 6 combined ranges
(Skeet Ranges Laporte Machines – Trap Ranges Laporte Machines)

10- Guns and Ammunition:

All information about shooter's Guns and Ammunition must be declared and sent not later than 5th OCT 2025 (Annex 8), Please submit the form fully completed and signed and stamped by the Federation. Please do not change the forms and do not use other forms. Incomplete or incorrect Forms will be returned, unprocessed. While in Kuwait, all guns and ammunition must be stored in the armory at the shooting range.

Delegations are advised that all teams and individuals/groups arriving separately should carry a signed and stamped copy of Annex 8 (Details Form for Guns and Ammunition) while both entering and departing Kuwait.

The storage of guns and ammunition in hotels and outside the shooting range is strictly prohibited. The armory will be open to facilitate the arrival (as previously advised in Annex 4) of official teams until departure.

Medals' ceremonies will take place daily as indicated in the provisional program. All teams must bring one copy of their national anthem (CD) and national flag(1 x 2 m) and deposit them with the Organizing Committee during the accreditation process.

14- Transportation/Airport:

Arrival Procedures

Participating teams will be met and facilitated on arrival at Kuwait International Airport. Teams will proceed to the visa office (as necessary) and then clear immigration and security controls. Participants will be transported to the Olympic Shooting Range to deposit their guns and then taken to their hotels.

Local Transportation

Transportation to and from the approval hotel from Organizing Committee to the Range will be arranged by the Organizing Committee for free during training and competition days only (**01- 07 Nov2025**), The bus schedules for transportation from the hotels to the ranges and back will be available at the Info Centre and in the official hotels.

Departure Procedures

Participating Federations should confirm their departure timetable with the Organizers (Annex 6) at least 48 hours prior to departure from Kuwait.
